ANALISIS REKRUTMEN CALON ANGGOTA LEGISLATIF PADA PEMILIHAN UMUM TAHUN 2019 PARTAI KEADILAN SEJAHTERA KABUPATEN OGAN KOMERING ULU

Partai politik yang menjadi satu satunya agen dalam perekrutan individu-individu dari masyarakat menjadi calon anggota legislatif, selanjutnya disingkat caleg, yang nantinya akan dipilih langsung oleh rakyat. Dengan demikian, kualitas seleksi dan model rekrutmen calon anggota legislatif dari partai politik akan berpengaruh terhadap kualitas calon yang akan bersaing dalam setiap pemilihan umum. Penelitian yang dilaksanakan pada tanggal 18 Februari sampai 20 Maret 2022 ini menggunakan metode deskriptif kualitatif. Berdasarkan hasil penelitian pola rekrutmen yang digunakan Partai Keadilan Sejahtera meliputi pola rekrutmen terbuka dan tertutup. Partai Keadilan Sejahtera membuka kesempatan luas kepada masyarakat untuk mendaftar sebagai calon legislatif mewakili partai. Partai Keadilan Sejahtera memberikan pengumuman kepada masyarakat lewat berbagai cara sosialisasi, yakni dengan pamflet, dan berbagai bentuk pengumuman di Dewan Pimpinan Daerah Partai Keadilan Sejahtera untuk caleg DPRD Provinsi, Dewan Pimpinan Daerah Partai Keadilan Sejahtera untuk caleg DPRD Kabupaten/ Kota. Beberapa kriteria yang digunakan PKS untuk menilai calon mana yang berhak lolos adalah Pertama, apakah Bakal calon legislatif masuk dalam instruktur partai. Kedua, keaktifan Bakal calon legislatif dalam berbagai kegiatan kepartaian, termasuk juga kontribusinya untuk partai. Ketiga, pemahaman Bakal calon legislatif tentang apa yang dia tulis, pemahaman dasar tentang platform partai, dan yang kelima pemahaman Bakal calon legislatif tentang mengartikulasikan kepentingan masyarakat. Selanjutnya DPW akan menetapkan daftar Bakal calon legislatif DPRD Kabupaten yang lolos seleksi dan menyampaikan kepada DPD dan DPC sesuai daerah pemilihan.

RECRUITMENT ANALYSIS OF PROSPECTIVE LEGISLATIVE MEMBERS IN THE 2019 GENERAL ELECTIONS AT THE PROSPERITY JUSTICE PARTY, OGAN KOMERING ULU REGENCY

Political parties are the only agents in terms of individuals from the community becoming candidates for legislative members, hereinafter abbreviated as caleg, who will be directly elected by the people. Thus, the quality of selection and the model for recruiting legislative candidates from political parties will affect the quality of candidates who will compete in every general election. This research was conducted from February 18 February until 20 March 2022 using a qualitative descriptive method. Results Based on the research, the recruitment pattern used by the Prosperous Justice Party includes open and closed recruitment patterns. The Prosperous Justice Party opens wide opportunities for the public to register as a legislative candidate to represent the party. The Prosperous Justice Party gave an announcement to the public through various socializations, namely with pamphlets, and various forms of distribution of the Regional Leadership Council for the candidates for the Provincial DPRD, the Regional Leadership Council of the Prosperous Justice Party for the candidates for the Regency DPRD. City. Some of the criteria used by PKS to assess which candidates are eligible to qualify are First, whether the prospective legislative candidates are included in the party structure. Second, the activeness of prospective legislative candidates in various activities, including their contribution to parties. Third, the understanding of the prospective legislative candidate (Bacaleg) about what he wrote, the basic understanding of the party platform, and the fifth understanding of the prospective legislative candidate about articulating the interests of the community. Furthermore, the DPW will determine the list of legislative candidates of the Regency DPRD who passed the selection and submit it to the DPD and DPC according to the electoral district.
