

ABSTRACT

Under the guidance of Rosmala Dewi, S.E., M.Si. and Maulana Hadi Kusuma, S.E., M.M.

The main purpose of this research was to determine the influence of Earning Per Share (EPS), Price to Book Value (PBV), and Debt to Equity Ratio (DER) on stock prices in cement subsector manufacturing companies listed on the IDX for the period 2019-2023, both partially and simultaneously. The population of this research consisted of 7 cement subsector companies listed on the Indonesia Stock Exchange (IDX) from 2019-2023. The sampling technique used was purposive sampling, with specific criteria, resulting in a sample of 6 cement subsector companies that met the predetermined criteria. The analysis method used in this research was panel data regression using Eviews 10 software. The results of this research showed that the variables Earning Per Share (EPS), Price To Book Value (PBV), and Debt To Equity Ratio (DER) simultaneously had a significant influence on stock prices. Partially, the variables Earning Per Share (EPS) and Debt To Equity Ratio (DER) had a significant positive influence, while the Price To Book Value (PBV) variable had a significant negative influence. Based on the results of the coefficient of determination test, the Adjusted R-squared value was 0.500138, indicating that the percentage contribution of the influence of the variables Earning Per Share (EPS), Price To Book Value (PBV), and Debt To Equity Ratio (DER) on stock prices in cement subsector manufacturing companies listed on the IDX for the period 2019-2023 was 50.0138%, while the remaining 49.9862% was influenced by other variables not examined in this research.

ABSTRAK

Muhammad Ridho Ramadhani (2024) Pengaruh *Earning Per Share* (EPS), *Price to Book Value* (PBV) Dan *Debt to Equity Ratio* (DER) Terhadap Harga Saham Pada Perusahaan Manufaktur Sub Sektor Semen Yang Terdaftar Di BEI Periode 2019-2023. Dibimbing oleh ibu Rosmala Dewi, S.E., M.Si. selaku Dosen Pembimbing I, dan Bapak Maulana Hadi Kusuma, S.E., M.M. selaku Dosen Pembimbing II.

Tujuan utama dari penelitian ini adalah untuk mengetahui pengaruh dari *Earning Per Share* (EPS), *Price to Book Value* (PBV) dan *Debt to Equity Ratio* (DER) Terhadap Harga Saham Pada Perusahaan Manufaktur Sub Sektor Semen Yang Terdaftar Di BEI Periode 2019-2023 secara parsial dan simultan. Populasi pada penelitian ini sebanyak 7 perusahaan sub sektor semen yang terdaftar di Bursa Efek Indonesia pada tahun 2019-2023. Teknik pengambilan sampel menggunakan teknik *Purposive Sampling*, dengan penentuan sampel dengan kriteria tertentu sehingga sampel yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini berjumlah 6 perusahaan sub sektor semen yang sesuai dengan kriteria yang telah ditentukan. Metode analisis pada penelitian ini menggunakan regresi data panel dengan menggunakan alat *Eviews 10*. Hasil penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa, variabel *Earning Per Share* (EPS), *Price To Book Value* (PBV) dan *Debt To Equity Ratio* (DER) secara simultan berpengaruh signifikan terhadap Harga Saham. Secara parsial variabel *Earning Per Share* (EPS), dan *Debt To Equity Ratio* (DER) berpengaruh signifikan dalam nilai positif, sedangkan variabel *Price To Book Value* (PBV) berpengaruh signifikan dalam nilai negatif. Berdasarkan hasil uji koefisien determinasi menunjukkan bahwa Nilai *Adjusted R-squared* sebesar 0,500138, hal ini menunjukkan bahwa persentase kontribusi pengaruh variabel *Earning Per Share* (EPS), *Price To Book Value* (PBV) dan *Debt To Equity Ratio* (DER) Terhadap Harga Saham Pada Perusahaan Manufaktur Sub Sektor Semen yang Terdaftar Di BEI Periode 2019-2023 sebesar 50,0138% sedangkan sisanya 49,9862% dipengaruhi oleh variabel lain yang tidak diteliti.
