Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui bagaimana stereotip etnis Sunda terhadap etnis Ogan di Talang Bandung Kelurahan Talang Jawa, Kec.Baturaja Barat. Penelitian ini menggunakan teori komunikasi identitas. Di mana dalam teori tersebut terbagi berdasarkan empat tahapan yaitu, *personal layer*, *enactment layer*, *relational* dan *communal*. hasil penelitian terlihat pada *personal layer* bahwa etnis Ogan memang mengakui bahwa mereka memiliki gaya bicara yang kasa dan lugas namun tidak memiliki maksud buruk, hal itu hanya disebabkan oleh pola asuh orang tua yang mengajarkan anak etnis organ untuk berani agar tidak diremehkan, sedangkan pada *enactment layer* terlihat bahwa perilaku yang ditampilkan oleh etnis organ memberikan stereotip bahwa etnis organ merupakan etnis yang kasar, keras, sompong berlebihan bahkan kurang ajar. Pada *relational* terlihat bahwa masyarakat etnis Ogan memiliki kecenderungan peradaaan superioritas terhadap etnisnya, merasa bahwa etnis organ lebih dahulu jadi etnis pendatanglah yang harus mengikuti kebiasaan etnis organ, pada *communal* terlihat dalam komunitas antar etnis, etnis organ memiliki dalam berbagai aspek kasar dan keras kepala, terlebih merasa bahwa masyarakat organ merupakan mayoritas sehingga tidak mau kalah terlebih etnis organ tetap memiliki stereotip bahwa etnis organ itu berbicara kasar dan keras, Bahkan *miss communication* kerap terjadi ketika terdapat perkumpulan antar etnis

This research aims to find out how Sundanese stereotypes of the Ogan people in Talang Bandung, Talang Jawa Village, West Baturaja District. This study uses the theory of identity communication. Where in theory is divided by four stages, namely, personal layer, activation layer, relational and communal. The results of the research are seen in the personal layer that Ogan ethnicity does admit that they have a strong and straightforward speaking style but have no bad intentions, which is only due to parenting that teaches ethnic children to be courageous not to be underestimated, While on the activation layer it appears that the behavior displayed by ethnic organ gives stereotypes that ethnic organ are harsh, harsh, overbearing and even insolent. Relational, it seems, that Ogan people have a tendency to have a sense of superiority over their ethnicity, feeling that it is first ethnic immigrants who must follow the customs of the ethnic Ogan people, in communal seen in inter-ethnic communities, that the ethnic Ogan people have in various aspects of being rude and stubborn. especially feel that the organ society is the majority so that it does not want to lose, especially the organ ethnicity still has a stereotype that the organ ethnicity speaks harshly and loudly, even miss communication often occurs when there are inter-ethnic groups.
